
Making a Difference One Boy at a Time Celebrating Two Boys Continuing Their Education

Although he clearly has genuine affection for his family, tensions with his mom were threatening to derail his efforts to complete his education. After taking the time to repeat a couple of courses to bring his marks up to the university level Kayne needed a more supportive living arrangement, and he found Huron House Boys' Home. His year here was spent mainly in the independent living program apartment upstairs, where he "tried not to cause trouble". The staff support and structures at

Huron House were just what he needed to help prepare him for university. He completed high school with marks in the high 80s and he is now studying Engineering at the University of Western Ontario.

Well into his first semester Kayne is doing very well, but finding the courses a bit too similar to his final year of high school to really challenge him. Fortunately he has learned patience, and he knows the increased learning and engineering competitions are coming, and looks forward to being fully involved.

Meanwhile he is settling into residence life, avoiding the rowdy parties that take place a little too often. He opts instead for studying and hanging out with more serious students. He also enjoys occasional visits from his family and spending time with his girlfriend.



Jawon too found success at Huron House. Once he figured out that the Boys' Home was an opportunity for a fresh start, he took full advantage and in his 3 ½ years here staff and residents became his second family. Apart from learning things like cooking, communication, time management and respect, Jawon was so impressed with how staff "were there for him" that he still comes for visits. He's particularly amazed at how, on days after he engaged in unusually bad behavior, staff would start fresh with him without animosity or grudges. Consequences were real, but so were acceptance and positive reinforcement.

Jawon is now living in an apartment while completing the Developmental Service Worker program at Lambton College. He is extremely grateful

for the continuing financial support from Huron House.

All things considered, it just wouldn't be right if our boys left 'home' without support, so when it became apparent that two of our youth were bound for higher education we wanted to make sure they were well supported.



Kayne and Jawon, are able to continue their studies because of the generosity of Lanxess, the Errol Egremont IODE Educational Bursary, the Skippon Educational Bursary and the Farndale Educational Bursary. Lanxess and its predecessor corporations have also been major sponsors of the Father's Day Run/Walk/Skate/Bike. Many participants will remember when it was known as the Bayer Boys' Home Run!
