Huron House Grad and Family Give Back

When Aiden graduated from Huron House in 2021, our staff received a heartfelt letter from his family thanking us for the care he received during his time with us and for the change that it made in their family. Aiden helped out at various fundraising events during his time living at Huron House, and much to our great appreciation, that hasn't changed now that he has returned to live with his family.

He hadn't been gone long when he reached out in response to a call for volunteers and said he would be happy to help. He signed up to be a regular volunteer working bingo shifts at Jackpot City. The funds that come from that (over \$15,000 each year!) are relied on to cover some of the costs of our large monthly grocery bill and are a big boost to our fundraising.

Aiden's grandmother often brought special snacks for the boys on Fridays when he lived here, a generous tradition that she still continues. Aiden often comes with her for the drop-offs and staff are always happy to see them both and catch up with what he's doing.

He and his grandmother were also great helps when Run/Walk/Skate/Bike returned in June and gave up their Sunday morning to help keep our breakfast tent running smoothly.

While staff often keep in touch with boys once they leave, it's not often that boys take the step to give back. We are so grateful for Aiden and his family for continuing to think of Huron House and help us make a difference in the lives of more youth, because they know first hand what a difference it made in theirs.

In addition to fun activities around our property and regular trips to the beach, the boys enjoyed weekly trips with destinations like Adrenaline Paintball, the adventure park at Boler Mountain, Canada's Wonderland, the Pinery, and St. Mary's Quarry. A couple lucky boys were even able to attend the Honda Indy in Toronto (with Paddock Passes) thanks to donated tickets we receive each year from Levitt Safety.

We had some great students join us over the summer working in fundraising, administration, groundskeeping, and directly with the boys. We have many building updates underway right now including new exterior doors, updating the boys' bedrooms with new furniture, and giving a fresh new look to our dining area. Work is happening outside too as the boys and staff put some hard work into updating our front gardens and lawn before the weather gets too cold.

We were thrilled to have one boy graduate and return to his family this summer, though sad to say goodbye, and we wish them all the best. We now have seven boys living on our main floor, plus two in our Independent Living Program. We're regularly receiving new referrals and will see that number grow again soon.
