Everyone's Favourite Father's Day Event





Inside Huron House

Since the start of the year, we've had three more boys join us at Huron House. We are consistently reviewing referrals from local and Ontario-wide organizations. There will be more boys joining us soon.

The boys have been enjoying lots of fun activities recently. Over March Break they visited District Beta, attended a Sting hockey game, played at The Factory in London, and watched a movie at the theatre. As the weather warms up, everyone is looking forward to enjoying the nearby parks, beaches, and nature trails.

We are currently working hard on a number of updates to our building and property. Thanks to a substantial grant from the Ministry of Health, we have been able to update our HVAC system, lighting, doors, windows, and storage sheds. While these updates aren't the most fun, they are necessary for the longevity of our facilities. In addition to these building upgrades, we are also revamping our outdoor sports court to provide an improved

outdoor recreation space for the boys.

This spring we are preparing for the arrival of some very exciting new Huron House residents - our chickens! The 'Breakfast Barn' chicken coop is going to be built in May. Then it will be time for us to prepare the space for our food garden. The boys will have the opportunity to get their hands dirty and learn how to collect eggs, care for chickens, and grow their own food. This will be a part of the new horticultural therapy program.

Three of our boys are graduating high school in June. We can't wait to celebrate their accomplishments and hard work. High school graduation means that these boys will soon be aging out of our care. It is bittersweet to say goodbye, but we are committed to supporting our boys as they begin their lives beyond the Boys' Home.

- Take something off your to-do list.
 Set it and forget it and don't have any end-of-year worry about whether or not you've made your donations.
- It's flexible. Stop or change it whenever you need. Option to choose cumulative or monthly tax receipts.

\$10- one month of toiletries for a boy

\$25—one month of school snacks for a boy

\$100—one month of counselling sessions for a boy

How do you set it up?

Visit our secure form at hhbh.ca/monthly and choose your donation amount, how often you would like to receive your tax receipts, and provide your contact information. That's it. You'll receive a confirmation email and be good to go!

Future donations will be taken on the same day of the month as your first monthly transaction, so pick whatever day works best for you.
