3. Register Your Event with Us

- Inform Huron House Boys' Home about your planned event.
- We can provide promotional materials, offer guidance, and ensure your event aligns with our mission and values.

Plan and Organize

- Location: Select a venue that suits your event's size and purpose. Ensure it's accessible and has the necessary facilities.
- **Date & Time:** Select a date that gives you enough time to plan and promote. Make sure the date avoids major holidays or local events that might conflict with your plans.
- **Budget:** Outline your expenses and potential revenue streams. Be sure to include venue rental, permits, and promotional materials. Aim to maximize funds raised by minimizing costs.
- **Permits and Licenses:** Depending on the event, you might need permits for public gatherings, food service, or alcohol consumption. Check local regulations and obtain necessary approvals.
- Volunteers: Recruit friends, family, or colleagues to help with the event.
